30th NOVEMBER, 1907.

### Stornoway Public Library.

14 Days allowed for reading this Volume.

The Library shall be open for issue and return of Books each lawful day (except Saturdays and public holidays) from 3 to 5 p.m. and from 7 to 8.30 p.m., and on Saturdays from 3 to 5 p.m.

Any Borrower who shall retain any Book or Books beyond the time specified above shall pay a penalty of One Penny per volume for every two days thereafter.

All Books shall be returned for examination on or before the 1st July in each year, on which date the issue of Books shall be suspended for such period as the Committee may appoint. Any person not returning a book or books shall be liable for the value thereof.

The occurrence of infectious disease in the Reader's house cancels the Reader's privilege for the time being.

Readers will be responsible for any damage done to books while in their possession.

Readers are requested to give notice of any defect or disfigurement they find in a Book when they receive it.

Books cannot be exchanged on day of issue.

## Lewis Hospital.

### ELEVENTH ANNUAL REPORT.

BETWEEN 30th November 1906, and 30th November, 1907, 78 patients were admitted to the Hospital, and with 2 patients, who were under treatment at 30th November, 1906, the total is 80. Of these 80 patients—

42 were cured.  
23 were relieved.  
2 discharged as incurable.  
3 died.  
2 transferred to other hospitals.  
8 remained under treatment.

Total ... 80

They came from the following places:—43 from Stornoway Parish; 11 from Barvas Parish; 14 from Uig Parish; 5 from Lochs; 2 from Hull; 1 each from Buckie, Grimsby and Aberdeen, and 2 from Harris.

In regard to the district nursing conducted by Queen's Nurse MacLennan, we have to report that 61 patients received treatment in their own homes, of whom 52 were adults and 9 children—involving 1741 visits throughout the year. The services of Nurse MacLennan are greatly appreciated.

#### HOSPITAL FUNDS.

The Management gratefully acknowledge the several donations and subscriptions as appearing in the appended lists, also the collections from Churches and proceeds from Entertainments and Levy from Boats. The income from these and other sources enables us to close the Accounts with a credit balance of £249 15s 4d.



Besides this, it is satisfactory to have to record an increase to Endowment of £282 1s 4d.

There have been no Legacies or Bequests during the year, but the Committee have received intimation that Mr K. D. Nicolson of Ravenswood, Tighnabruaich, has left a Legacy of £1000 for the Hospital.

Individual acknowledgment of the many gifts and donations is impossible, but to one and all the Committee tender their sincere thanks. We should like, however, to express our thanks to Lewis Natives in different parts of the world for their continual remembrance of, and, in several cases, handsome contributions to, the Hospital. Such an interest in the Hospital is most gratifying; also to the Doctors and Staff; to Mr Forbes and Mr John Macleod for Sunday services regularly held, and to the "Highland News" for acknowledging from time to time the many gifts and donations.

Since our last Report the Hospital has lost a generous patron and supporter by the death of Mr Joe A. Platt, Eishken. Not only was he an annual subscriber, but he and Mrs Platt made many handsome gifts of furnishings, &c.

Sheriff Squair, our esteemed Chairman, though he has not resumed his place at the Committee, is, we are glad to learn, much improved in health.
