

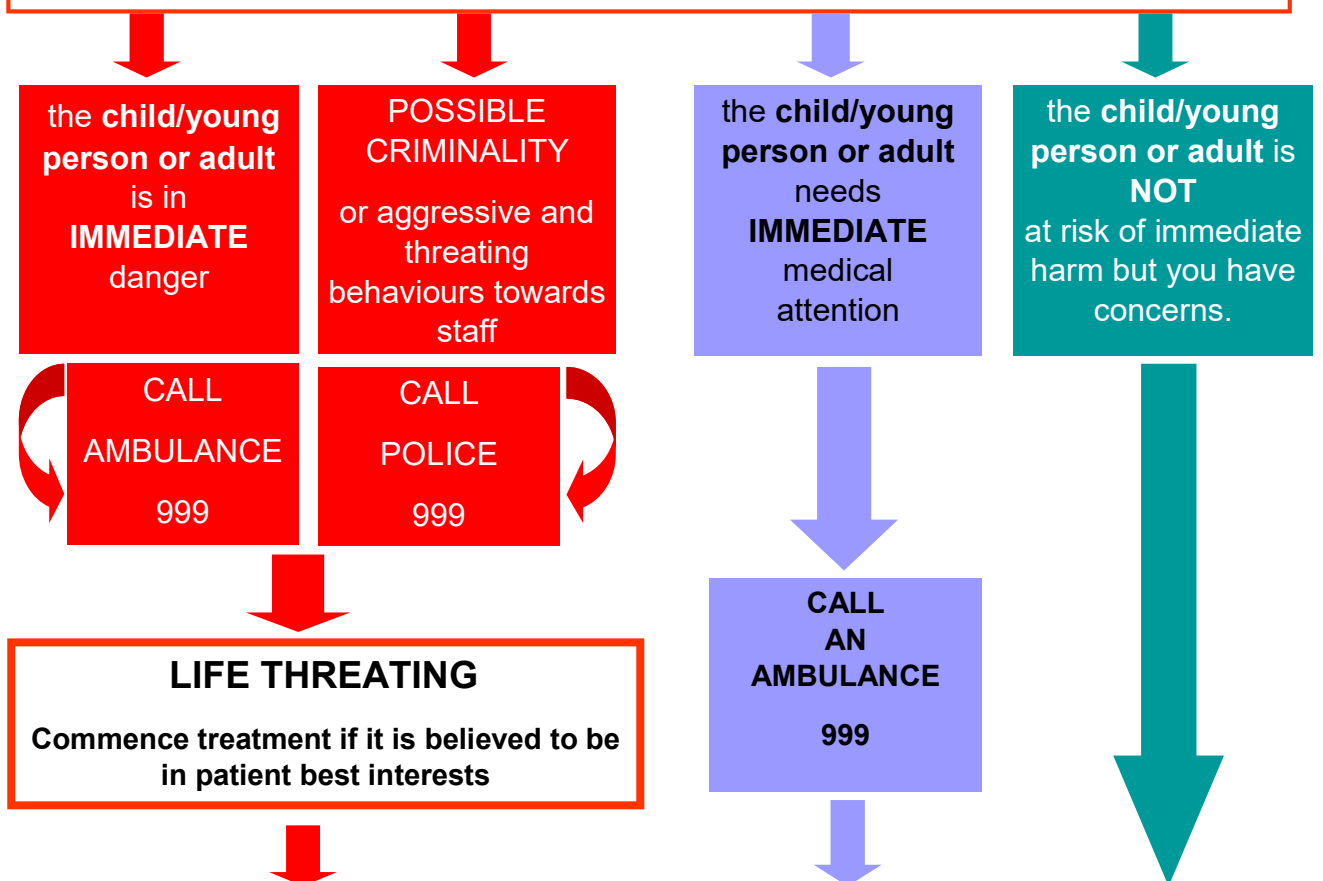
# PUBLIC PROTECTION REPORTING CONCERN PROTOCOL CHILD/YOUNG PERSON OR ADULT

## INFORMATION RECEIVED

You suspect a child/young person or adult is being harmed.  
You have seen an child/young person or adult is being harmed.  
A child/young person or adult has told you they are being harmed.

What is harm? Who is at risk of harm?

## IN ALL CASES

You have a duty to report harm, even if the child/young person or adult does not want you to it is good practice to inform the child/young person or adult that you are reporting harm.

Inform your line manager and follow your organisation's  
Child and Adult Protection procedures.

Complete Child concern referral form email copy as instructed on form.

For Adult concerns provide a summary of concerns and email.
