Disability Access

The centre is DDA compliant.

There is a lift in the centre and a wheelchair available at reception. We have one surgery which has a wheelchair platform.

Emergency Care

If you have a dental emergency please contact the Centre as early as possible.

Out with the Centre opening hours please contact NHS 24, freephone 111.

Cancellations

If you cannot attend your dental appointment please contact the centre as soon as possible.

The receptionist will arrange another suitable appointment for you.

Appointments

Routine examination appointments will usually last between 20-30 minutes.

For follow-up appointments reception staff will give you an indication of the approximate length of your appointment time.

Occasionally a clinician may run behind schedule, reception staff will keep you informed if this is the case.

Dental Charges

Every patient will receive a free dental examination and charges may apply for further treatment. Please ask at reception for an estimate.

Payment should be made at each appointment. Acceptable payment methods are by credit/debit card, cash or cheque.

If you are exempt from NHS dental charges, please bring evidence of your exemption along to your appointment.
