Timeline of Screening Programmes in Scotland

AAA (Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm) screening All men and people assigned male at birth in Scotland aged 65 are invited to attend AAA screening, it is a one off screening **Bowel screening** Everyone in Scotland between the ages 50 to 74 are offered bowel screening. If you are 75 or over, you can request 50 a test every 2 years 50 **Breast screening** Females* between the ages of 50 and 70 are offered breast screening every 3 years **Cervical screening** Anyone with a cervix is offered screening between the ages of 25 and 64 every 5 years 12 Diabetic eye screening An eye screening test is offered regularly to people with diabetes from age 12 **Pregnancy and newborn** screening Screening is offered at various stages of pregnancy and during the baby's first few days
