

Timeline of Screening Programmes in Scotland

AAA (Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm) screening

All men and people assigned male at birth in Scotland **aged 65** are invited to attend AAA screening, it is a one off screening

Bowel screening

Everyone in Scotland between the ages 50 to 74 are offered bowel screening. If you are 75 or over, you can request a test every 2 years

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Breast screening

Females* between the ages of 50 and 70 are offered breast screening **every 3 years**

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Cervical screening

Anyone with a cervix is offered screening between the ages of **25 and 64** every **5 years**

Diabetic eye screening

An eye screening test is offered regularly to people with diabetes from age **12**

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Pregnancy and newborn screening

Screening is offered at various **stages of pregnancy** and during the **baby's first few days**
